

Level 1 Route Setter – Job Description

Role Overview

As a Level 1 Route Setter, you will assist the setting team with all aspects of the route setting procedures. Your primary responsibilities will include safely stripping and washing holds and setting under supervision from senior setters. This role is an entry-level position designed to develop skills and knowledge within a structured progression framework.

Key Responsibilities

- Safely strip and wash climbing holds.
- Assist in setting problems under supervision from a Level 2 or Level 3 setter.
- Ensure the safe use, storage, and organization of all setting-related equipment.
- Adhere to safety protocols and company guidelines while performing setting duties.

Key Skills & Requirements

- Experience climbing multiple grade boundaries with a basic understanding of movement and climbing technique.
- Ability to safely use basic setting equipment.
- Willingness to learn and receive constructive feedback from senior setters.
- Awareness of workplace safety and best practices in a climbing environment.
